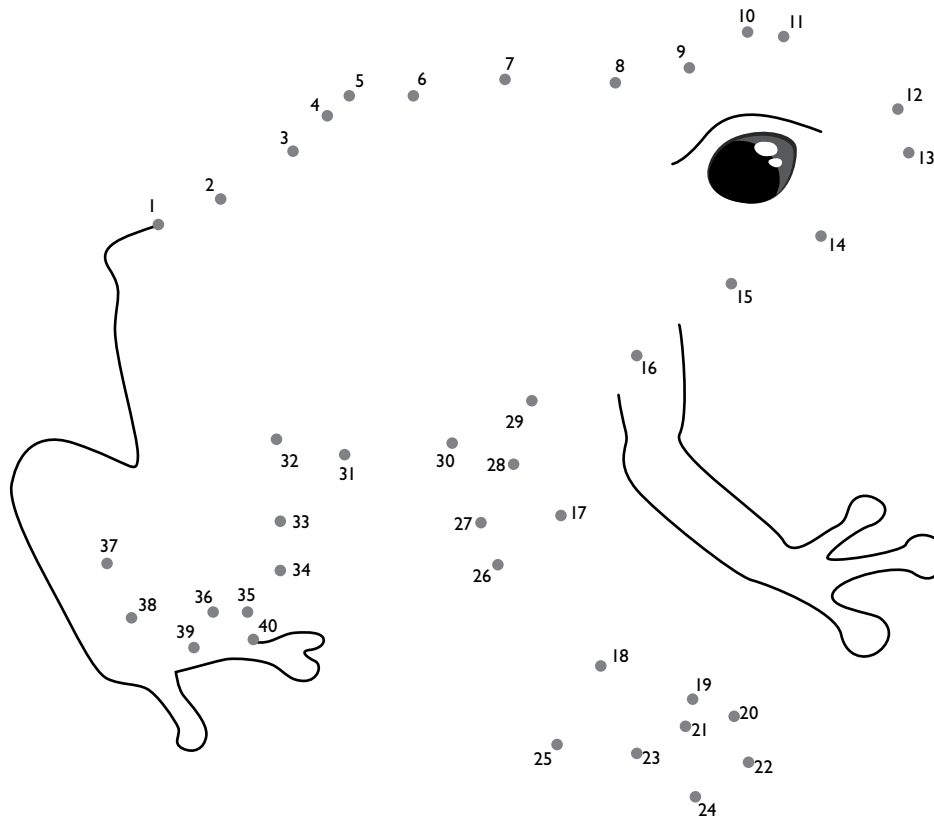

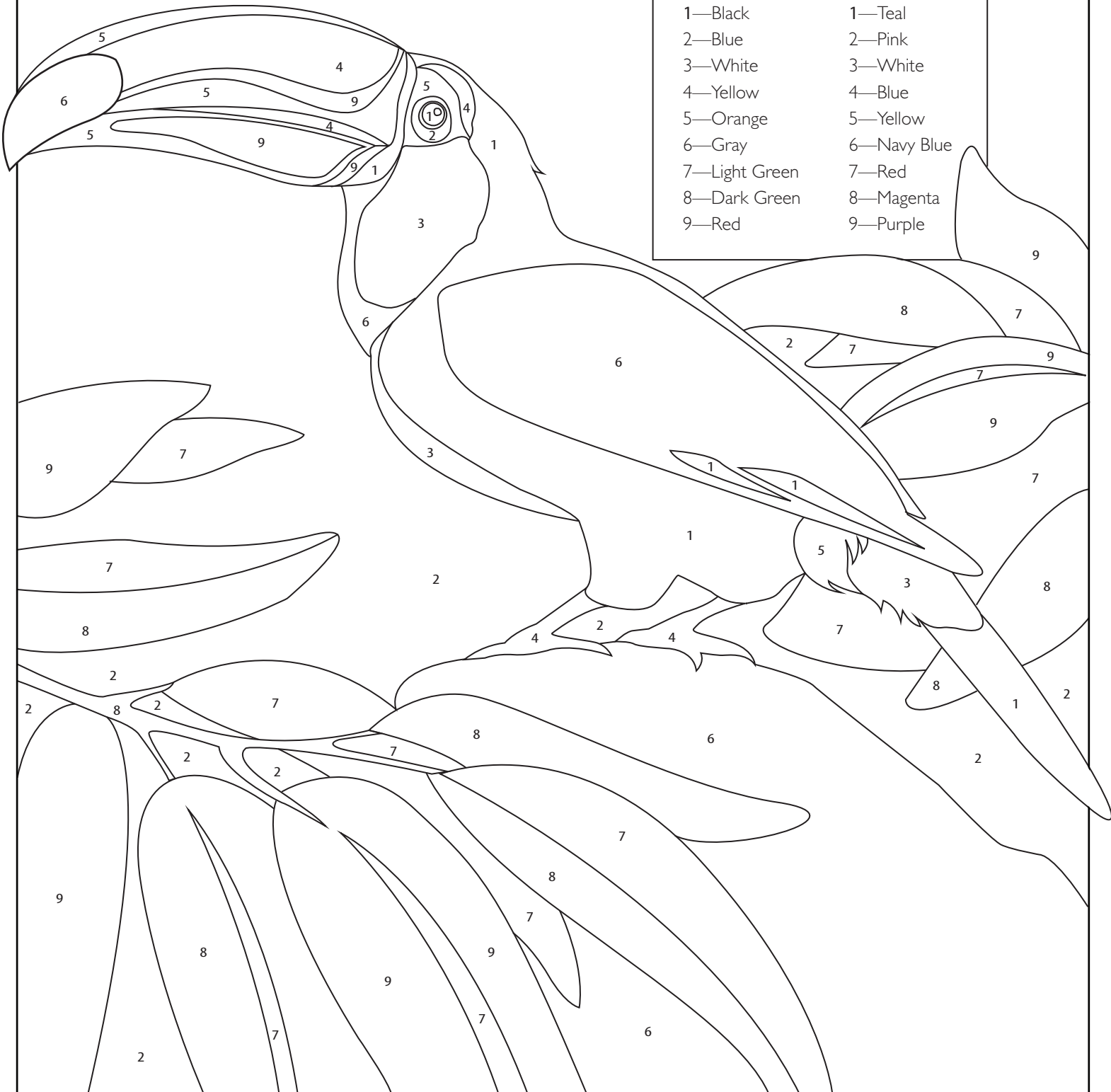



Your neighborhood is home to tons of animals! Take a nature walk as if you were one of them. If you want, take photos along the way and plan to have a virtual show and tell with a friend.




Find a cozy **hidey-hole** where you might make a home in if you were a squirrel.




Seek out a dark and damp place you would like to crawl around in if you were a **beetle**.




What is one thing you see that you think needs to be **protected**?




As a tree frog, where would you choose to **cool off**?




If you could get into **mischief** as a rascally raccoon, where would you do it and what would you do?
